

Parent Reminder

Emergency Kits are due now!

Returning parents please check the list below and make sure that your kit is current. Also please be sure that none of the items in your kit are out of date and that the water is fresh.

Every child at Kenter Canyon is required by LAUSD to have an emergency kit! Please put your kit together as soon as possible. *****All kits are due by October 30th.**

The assembly of these kits requires a minimal amount of effort from you and will help protect the most basic needs of your child in the event of an emergency.

Supplies can be placed in a 1 or 2 gallon Ziploc bag. Please be sure to write your child's name on the outside of the bag. All kits will be returned at the end of the school year.

Please include:

- **At least 16 oz of water** in an unopened bottle.
- **Non Perishable Snacks:** energy/protein or meal replacement bars, ready to eat canned fruit, veggies or tuna (preferably with a pop to; requires no cooking), dried fruit, fruit or dried meat jerkys, dry cereal in small boxes, crackers, "favorite" foods that are comforting and nutritious. Please try to avoid very salty and sugary items.
- **One Emergency Space Blanket:** These blankets are made of mylar and can be found at sporting goods and surplus stores.
- **A flashlight with new batteries or 12-hour light stick.**
- **A family photo.**
- **A comforting note to your child.**
- **An Emergency Card.** This should include all important information about your child. Phone numbers, nearest relatives/friends and their contact numbers. A signed permission card to indicate who may pick up your child. Please seal this information in an envelope marked "Emergency Information".
- **Does your child require Medications?** Please include three days worth of medications, with instructions for the teacher on their administration. Please label and seal in a Ziploc. Please also note any allergies.
- **Extras:** small toy, deck of cards, something entertaining, etc. A light change of clothes, moist towelettes or wipes.
